- While the material is under review, it will remain available in circulation.
- Once a material has been fully reviewed, further request forms for the same title will not be considered for three years.
- If the patron is dissatisfied with the results of the librarian review, they may appeal the decision to the Library Board of Trustees.
- Only five forms per patron will be accepted per quarter to allow for the formal review process.
